Station Food Distributors:

- Responsible to distribute select food to families in the food train.
- Each Station will hand out food to both sides of vehicle for a total of four lanes.
- Families will drive through the lanes to fill their cars/boxes. Each station will be responsible for 1 to 4 food items
- Tell the vehicle to move forward once both sides have been filled. You will need to be aligned with your partners across the lane, so everyone is out of harms path.

Thank you so much for volunteering for Families helping Families. This is the **8**th **year** providing a week's worth of groceries to families in need during the Thanksgiving holiday.



Table 1: Covid check

- Ensure each volunteer has a face covering over their nose and mouth
- Conduct Temperature Check. If they have a temperature. The volunteer will need to leave.
- Review the Covid-19 check list and rules.
- Have the volunteer fill in name, date and sign the covid form
- Put covid form in plastic bin

Table 2: Event check in

- Sign in the volunteer & mark off role sheet to ensure no gaps.
- QR Code for volunteer guide & maps
- Or ask that the volunteers take pictures of the information provided
- Guide them to their respective locations via the map

Family Registration:

Check in families as they come into the lot. Please let the family know that masks are mandatory when window is down. If they don't have masks, please provide masks in a contactless manner. Try and social distance with the vehicles. Kindly remind families to remain in their vehicle.

- Scan the QR code to check the family
 - Officer will ask for them to have their QR Code ready via Eventbrite app, screenshot or print out.
- Explain directions for the food train / show them a map
- If they are checking in multiple families, mark their upper windshield with the #. (ON THE GLASS ONLY)
- Ask families to have patience as we try to help everyone throughout the day.

"Box Building" Special Pick Up & Delivery Team

Volunteer Role: Special Pick Up & Delivery Team

Team Lead: Ritu & Randy Balla

Team will be responsible for providing pre-built boxes & bags of food to the cars delivering to homes of families with out vehicles.

Will utilize lane 1 to fill boxes for deliveries and cars delivering food to multiple families.

Police cars & cars with numbers on their vehicles will be filled for delivery.

Each car including the police car will have the number of families after registered with Family Registration.

Fill the vehicle with the food & wipe off the number from the windshield.
